This program is specifically developed for young offenders who have a history of substance use and problematic behaviour.

The program content encourages group members to self-evaluate, identify and work towards acceptance and accountability around their specific issues and identify strategies that may assist in making better life choices and avoiding a criminally entrenched pathway and move towards a prosocial lifestyle.

It is followed by a series of individual counselling sessions that focus on supporting participants to transition back into the community.

AADS can also offer the program 180 degrees which is same program with less cultural specific content. Which was developed as a request to suit both Aboriginal and non- Aboriginal clients.
